Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 2 Visit to Lincoln Castle - Wednesday 18th September 2024

As part of our History topic this term, we will be learning about castles and finding out why William the Conqueror built Lincoln Castle.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 18thSeptember – leaving at 9:00am and returning at approximately 3.15pm

During the day we will be going for a walk along the castle walls to learn about the history of the castle and identify the parts of the castle. During the walk, the children will have the opportunity to take in the amazing view over Lincoln and stop for a moment to appreciate the view of Lincoln Cathedral.

The children will also see a dragon caught in the wall of the castle and will use these as inspiration for their writing back in school.

To cover the cost of the trip, there is a voluntary contribution of £13.75 for your child to attend the trip which should be made via ParentPay. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As parent/carer, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please book an appointment with Diane Mulley or a member of the SLT.

The children will need to wear school uniform. As we will be outside for most of the day, please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear for the weather conditions.

PACKED LUNCH - We can provide your child with a packed lunch for this trip. This will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, biscuit and a drink. Please complete the choice of cheese or ham sandwich on the reply slip attached. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please indicate this on the form. If you do send a packed lunch with your child it will need to be put in a disposable bag as we will throw these away after lunch. Your child will still need to bring a drink with them for during the day.

Please make your payment via ParentPay and return the consent slip to your child's Class Teacher by Wednesday 11th September.
