Educational Visit to Nene Outdoors – Investigating Rivers Thursday 13th June (Y3SD and Y3TS) Thursday 27th June 2024 (Y3SH)

Our Geography topic in Year 3 focuses on Investigating Rivers. As part of this topic, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at Nene Outdoors, Peterborough on Thursday 13th June for Y3SD and Y3TS and Thursday 27th June 2024 for Y3SH.

The Nene Outdoors Education Centre has arranged various activities throughout the day to investigate Living Rivers, including carrying out a river study on a section of the river and developing their map reading skills to follow a route along the river, locating points of interest and discussing the physical and human processes influencing the river environment. It will be an exciting day which will bring the study of Rivers to life. We will be using this as a vehicle for first hand writing opportunities and other cross curricular links throughout our Learning Journey.

The bus will leave at **9.00am** so we ask that the children arrive promptly at **8:35am** for registration. They will return to school for approximately **3:00pm**. There is a voluntary contribution of **£16.82** for your child to attend the trip which must be made via ParentPay. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As a parent/carer, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties making the payment, please make an appointment to speak to Diane Mulley. **All permission slips should be returned by Friday 7th June 2024.**

The children will need to wear school uniform. As most of the day will be spent outside, please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear for the weather conditions. We would advise that girls wear trousers and if the weather is particularly warm that children wear hats and apply suncream before they arrive at school.
