Year 4 Visit to The Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham Tuesday 25th June and Wednesday 26th June 2024

As part of our RE topic this term, we will be learning about the pilgrimages. As part of this topic, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at The Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham in Walsingham.

This medieval place of pilgrimage, which rivalled Canterbury, was visited by thousands of pilgrims from across Britain and Europe. Walsingham became known as 'England's Nazareth' because of the nature of the vision which the Lady Richeldis experienced. In the modern era, the past 100 years have witnessed the dramatic restoration of pilgrimage to Walsingham.

The Education Department is dedicated to providing opportunities to promote students' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development through curriculum based programmes with a special emphasis on Christian faith.

The trip will take place on:

Tuesday 25th June – Y4SS and 16 members of Y4KR Wednesday 26th June - Y4LB and remaining members of Y4KR

The coach will leave school at 9am and will return at approximately 4pm
